Nye County Republican Party 2016 PLATFORMS

- 1. We recognize the Bill of Rights as inalienable rights untouchable by the hand of any government. Our elected officials shall respect these rights. We demand strict adherence to all, but especially to the 2nd Amendment, with no infringements, allowing citizens to keep and bear arms of any type.
- 2. We strongly resist the nationalization and/or militarization of our law enforcement agencies. We support the concept of the locally elected Constitutional County Sheriff being the supreme authority of law enforcement in a community. We refuse to allow Homeland Security and all Non-Government Organizations to influence our Law Enforcement Agencies.
- 3. We support less government, lower taxes, less regulation, more individual liberties and personal responsibility. We further demand transparency and accountability at all levels of government. We also demand that all public policy decisions be made by accountable elected legislators, not unelected bureaucrats.
- 4. We are adamantly opposed to the incorporation of our towns/communities which increases the size, scope and cost of government.
- 5. We demand an end to illegal immigrants receiving benefits from any local government programs and that existing laws be enforced.
- 6. We demand that juries be informed and educated of their duties to decide on both the law, and the facts as they apply to each case they hear, so that justice is the main priority.
- 7. We support a return to a more independent, self-sufficient society. We support self-reliance in our local communities by supporting local agriculture, utility independence, and more localized and individual solutions.
- 8. We strongly oppose new limits on domestic wells and the implementation of Rapid Infiltration Basins (RIBs) of waste water not yet treated to consumable standards. We support development in Nye County that does not surpass the availability of water resources within our borders.
- 9. We demand an end to electronic voting machines being utilized without a paper backup. Further, we oppose registration on the same day as voting. We must demand proof of residency and citizenship to register, and photo identification at the time of voting. Any citizen has the right to observe an official vote count for any public election.
- 10. We oppose government encroachment on private property rights of any kind, and we demand both the return of our rights to access public land, and the return of federal lands in Nevada to state control.
- 11. We believe that the education of children should be first and foremost in the hands of the parents and local control. We are against any national mandates of any kind including Common Core.
- 12. We support an all-volunteer fire department except for fire chief and 2nd in command.
